MEMORANDUM OF DEMAND

To: The Office of the Premier of Gauteng, Premier Panyaza Lesufi

From: Democratic Alliance, Emfuleni

Date: 21 October 2024

Subject: Fulfilment of promises made to the residents of Emfuleni

With this memorandum, we demand immediate action on the promises made on the 1st of November 2023, when a petition for the improvement of electricity supply was heard by the NCOP Public Petitions and Executive undertakings.

The Gauteng Department of Cooperative Government and Traditional Affairs (COGTA) undertook, and premier Panyaza Lesufi announced that interventions in terms of Eskom and municipality-supplied areas in the municipality would be undertaken.

Those being:

- Transformer replacements and installations;

The transformers in question include some that had come to the end of their lives, and those that had been out of service for extended periods.

These promises must be promptly fulfilled. It is our understanding that these commitments were made with the intent of improving life in Emfuleni and ensuring the well-being of our community. However, we have yet to see substantial progress on these pledges, despite the expectations you set.

We respectfully remind you that the credibility of governance hinges on the ability to deliver on promises. Transparency and accountability are crucial in maintaining public trust, and it is imperative that your office provides an update on the status of these commitments.

We expect a response outlining the steps that are being taken to address this matter, along with an updated timeline for fulfilment.

We look forward to your prompt attention to this issue.
